



Guidelines and Application

The \$5,000 Student Scholarship will be presented at the Annual General Meeting. **Application must be received no later than the end of September.**

(Part I)

GUIDELINES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Woolworths Employees' Credit Union Student Scholarship Award will be launched in July each year. The closing date for all applications will be the end of September each year.

The following are guidelines for applying for a Woolworths Employees' Credit Union Student Scholarship.

The eligibility criteria is as follows:

- ✓ Only year 12 students are eligible.
- ✓ A top grade point average B+ in the current school.
- ✓ Received acceptance to an accredited college, university or vocational school if already confirmed.
- ✓ Student applicant must be a child of a Woolworths employee during the selection process or work for Woolworths.

Application is made by:

Writing a letter to the Scholarship Selection Committee that includes the following:

- ✓ Application form
 Official current transcript of high school grades current and prior years marks.
- ✓ Essay written by applicant stating why he/she should receive this scholarship
- ✓ Anticipated field of study

Secure letters of reference or recommendation from each of the following:

- ✓ A Secondary school teacher or counselor addressing the student's performance; involvement in school activities; quality of coursework completed, and potential for successful academic performance in a college, university or vocational environment.
- ✓ Confirming letter from Parents/ Guardians
- ✓ Optional Please include your photo with application. (Photo may be used in credit union newsletter if you are selected as a scholarship recipient).

Nomination process:

- ✓ Three nominated applications will be selected from those received for the interview stage.
- ✓ Interviews will be conducted in October, either face to face or conference call.

The Student Scholarship funds are controlled by WECU and are strictly for the use of further education in any field of endeavour and no further correspondence as to selection will be entered into.
